Sri Sarada College for Women, Tirunelveli was founded in 1986, by Srimat Swami Chidbhavananda Maharaj, the great Saint, Seer and Savant widely known, for the power and depth of his spirituality, to cater the educational needs, of the women of the Southern Districts of Tamilnadu. It is an unaided college, originally affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University, till 1990. After the establishment of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University in 1990, our college has been affiliated to the same. Character Building and Culture Inculcation are the basis upon which the super structure of modern education is raised here.

Holy Mother Sri Sarada Devi's unseeing power, has guided us to succeed all these thirty four years. Started with the noble purpose of providing opportunities of higher education to the rural women, the College was started with 60 students in 3 UG courses. Now after 35 years, the college has grown to a Students' strength of 1600 with 11 UG programmes i.e. B.A., - Economics, B.A., English, B.Sc., Mathematics, B.Sc., Physics, B.Sc., Chemistry, B.Sc., Computer Science and B.Sc., Information Technology, B.C.A., B.Com., B.Com.(C.S) and BBA and 6 PG programmes i.e. MCA, M.Com., M.A. English, M.Sc. Mathematics, M.Sc Physics and M.Sc (Computer Science), 4 Research programmes i.e M.Phil., in Commerce English, Mathematics, Computer Science & Two Doctoral programmes viz Computer Science and Commerce. 90 qualified and dedicated teachers instruct the students producing excellent results and many ranks in the University examinations every year.

Infrastructural facilities are fully equipped. Our computer laboratories for UG & PG have a sum of 219 Computers with necessary accessories and peripherals, full-fledged Library both –central and departmental, and technological teaching aids like OHP and LCD projectors for all departments, smart class, and Nano lab for M.Sc., Physics Students help to improve the teaching and learning process. We have received ISBN Numbers for our Institution's Publications. Pragnavani, a bi- Annual Journal is being published by our college.

ENGLISH DIGITAL LAB

Most of our college students are from rural area and first generation learners. English Communication Skill course of 60 hours is conducted in our college by Guimax Pvt Ltd, Palayamkottai. 424 students have gained by this Global English Proficiency Programme. These classes are conducted beyond the college hours.

SARADALIBRARY

Our College library has 30,604 books, 49 Magazines and 49 journals. E-magazine such as The Light of Vedanta, The Voice of Jagat Guru, Science Reporter & 7 News papers are available in our library. Our students utilize this facility during the library hour and after the college hours. Books are issued from the Book Bank also. Our college is the member of Delnet and N-List. Our library is automated with Koha software. Inatitutional Repository D-Space is available in our library. NPTEL Local Chapter is in our College and online examinations are conducted in the month of April & November 2020. Our students have participated in the examination. Gandeevam a student's magazine is published quarterly. Readers forum conduct meetings once in two months.

VALUE EDUCATION
