The Programme Outcomes for postgraduate students typically include mastery of the subject knowledge, its application in pertinent contexts, learning teaching skills, preparation for higher education, and so forth. For undergraduate programmes, the programme outcomes can include comprehension of the course or subject concepts, learning effective communication skills both in English and in their native tongues, and preparation for higher education.
