7.1.5 The Institutional Initiatives for Greening the Campus

The institution is deeply committed to environmental sustainability and ecological balance through a range of green campus initiatives. The following proactive steps have been taken to reduce the ecological footprint and promote a healthy, green environment:

1. Restricted Entry of Automobiles

To minimize air and dust pollution, the entry of motor vehicles into the main academic area is strictly prohibited. Visitors' vehicles are parked outside the campus, and designated parking zones are established near the main entrance to control vehicular movement.

2. Use of Bicycles and Battery-Powered Vehicles

Students and staff are encouraged to use bicycles and public transportation. The college facilitates Government Transport services exclusively for students during the commencement and conclusion of college hours, ensuring safe, timely and eco-conscious travel. Bicycles are promoted as a means to reduce carbon emissions and promote health and eco-awareness.

3. Pedestrian-Friendly Pathways


The campus features well-maintained, well-lit, and pest-free pedestrian pathways that ensure safe, comfortable, and environmentally friendly mobility across the campus premises.

4. Ban on the Use of Plastics


