## 7.1.1 – The Institution has a Divyangjan-Friendly and Barrier-Free Environment

The Institution is committed to promoting inclusivity and accessibility by ensuring a *Divyangjan-friendly* and barrier-free environment. A range of facilities and assistive technologies have been implemented to empower students with disabilities, enabling them to navigate the campus with dignity and independence.

1. The campus buildings are equipped with gentle-sloped ramps to facilitate easy movement for individuals with mobility challenges. These access points connect classrooms, laboratories and administrative blocks seamlessly.
2. Accessible restrooms are located in the Sarada Block and MCA Block, featuring non-slip floors, sliding doors, grab bars, and adapted wash basins/RO water provision. These facilities offer comfort and convenience for differently abled individuals.
3. Signage with tactile paths made of paver blocks, directional display boards, and informational signposts are provided to help *Divyangjan* navigate key locations such as academic blocks, laboratories, hostels, schools, healthcare centres (HCC), ATMs, the main office, and the central library.
4. Braille scripts are available in the central library, which are helpful for students who are blind and blind deaf. It helps to promoting equitable access to knowledge for physically challenged.
5. The institution provides screen-reading software such as Navda are available to assist with real-time campus navigation and digital support for persons with disabilities.

Through these continuous efforts, the college fosters an inclusive academic ecosystem, upholding the values of equity, dignity, and universal access in higher education.
